Learning Outcomes

- Successfully master the respective specialisations in journalism, including photography, video, editing (photos and videos), packaging, story generating, ideating, interviewing techniques, listening and research skills, information management, and refining material at both undergraduate and post-graduate levels.

- 3. To have an added qualification at a University-affiliated college while simultaneously pursuing BMM or MA Communication and Journalism degree.
- 4. Produce an independent research project or a series of in-depth stories in different formats on diverse topics of interest that cater to the respective industry's demand.

The one-month course imparted by industry professionals entails a total of four working weeks. Each course will be held thrice a week in two-hours sessions. The courses have been divided in two phases, and the first phase will be operationalised from 13th July 2020 to 13th Aug 2020. The second phase will be announced in due course.
