Curriculum Details:

Day 1: Introduction to the Workshop, the facilitators and participants. Basics of Media followed by interaction Basics of the art of observation Brief on exercise of the day

Day 2: Basics of Photography Reflections on film making and film form today - A documentary filmmaker and cinematographer's perspective; followed by interaction Basics of sound & tips of Recording Sound on Smart Phone Brief on exercise of the day

Day 3: Reading and discussing select exercises from Day 1 & 2 – understanding basic techniques and film form better. Brief on exercise of the day

Day 4: Lecture on - Idea to Film - How to develop ideas to actualize them into films followed by interaction. Basics of Cinematography and Tips of Shooting with smart phone followed by interactions Brief on exercise of the day

Day 5: (Shooting day) One-on-one sessions with participants to prepare them for their short film productions. Participants may begin shooting their own short films after one-on-one inputs.

Day 6: (Shooting / Editing day) Lecture on 'Basics of editing' and editing with open source softwares. Participants may begin editing their own short films.



(Each a 'Party' and together the 'Parties') WHEREAS;

The Parties have agreed to work together to deliver a platform to Mass Media Students w.r.t. organizing of special screenings of select films of MIFF as part of Off-Campus Screening of 16th MIFF-2020 during 28th January, 2020 to 3rd February, 2020; details of which are contained in the Schedules to this Agreement. The collaboration is with FILMS DIVISION, MINISTRY OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING (FIRST PARTY), INDIAN DOCUMENTRY PRODUCERS ASSOCIATION (SECOND PARTY) AND DEVIPRASAD GOENKA MANAGEMENT COLLEGE OF MEDIA STUDIES (THIRD PARTY)

NOW IT IS HEREBY AGREED as follows:

1. Terms of Agreement

- A spot registration desk for MIFF entries will be facilitated.
- Volunteers for MIFF
- Promotion for MIFF
- Publicity for proposed special special screening.

Whereas;

The First and second party will be providing following to third party:

- Packages for the movie screening.
- Invites for all the formal functions as Special Guest.
- Certificates to the volunteers.
- Certificate of appreciation to the institute.
- Facilitate Student Visit for the Mass media students of the institute to Films Division and NMIC.
- Platform to connect with Industry experts at Master Classes & Workshop during MIFF with pre-registration
- Guest session by members as and when possible.
- Linkages to other institutes.
- Package of MIFF award winning for screening at institute once in a year.

2. General Obligations

- 2.1 Each Party shall provide the Student with the academic and administrative support and services in accordance with the Memoranda of Cooperation and their Administrative Schedule and achieve the standards for the collaboration in the manner set out in this Agreement
- 2.2 Each Party shall fulfill its obligations under this Agreement in such a way as to ensure is activities do not compromise or bring into disrepute either itself or the other Party.

3. Obligations Regarding Information

3.1 Each of the Parties shall provide each of the Students with the information referred to in the Administrative Schedule.

4. Financial Schedule

4.1 There will be no financial implications on either parties or the beneficiary.

5. Administration and Management

- 5.1 The Chief Executive will appoint a senior member of staff to have responsibility for managing the Agreement-on behalf of the all three parties (and may change such nominee by written notice at any time).
- 5.2 The Memorandum of Cooperation shall identify the relevant faculties of the First Party and the Second Party responsible for the academic management and delivery of Course.

6. Confidentiality

Each Party undertakes to keep confidential information (written and oral) of a confidential nature concerning the business and affairs of the other (including confidential information regarding Students) that it shall have obtained and received as a result of the discussions leading up to or the entering into of this Agreement or during the course of this Agreement.




Esteemed Key Note Speaker

As a Screenwriter, Anu has co-written AARYA Season 1 and Season 2, a 9-part Family Crime Series created by Ram Madhvani, . She has co-written 'GRAHAN', inspired by a Hindi novel 'Chaurasee'. She has also adapted a YA novel into a film for Adlabs. Anu is also adapting the well-accclaimed The Great India Kitchen' into Hindi. Not the one to take a moment's respite, she has also co-written a show for Matchbox to be directed by Hansal Mehta.

She wrote and directed a five-part web series 'The Good Girl Show' released during Women's Day Week in 2017, which notched up more than five million views on YouTube, the reverse adaptation of which was published as her next book - a novel called 'Bhali Ladkiyaan, Buri Ladkiyaan' by Amazon-Westland.

Anu's collection of short stories, 'Neela Scarf, has been a bestseller, 'Mamma ki Diary, a memoir on modern day marriage and parenting is available as an Audible podcast.

Anu was awarded the Ramnath Goenka Award for Excellence in Journalism in 2013 and the LAADLI Media and Advertising Award in 2012 for her stories for a leading rural newspaper called 'Gaon Connection'. She started her career as a Journalist with NDTV, and has been a Consultant/Faculty with the Star Writers Program run by Star India. She was also a consulting commissioning editor at HarperCollins.
