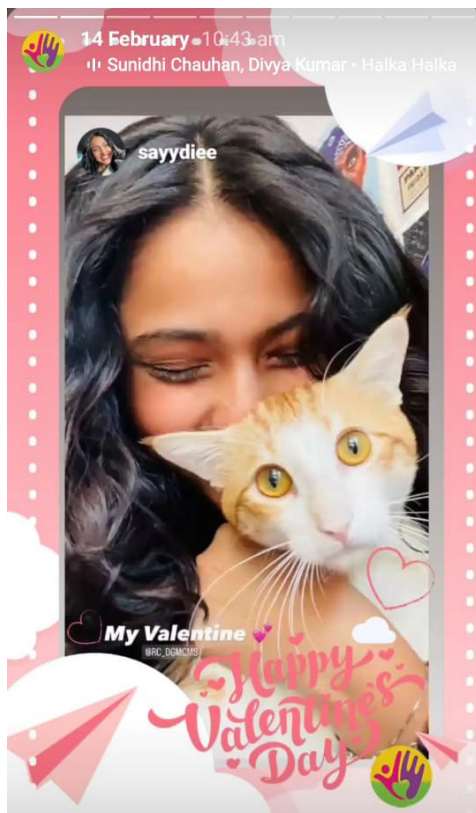

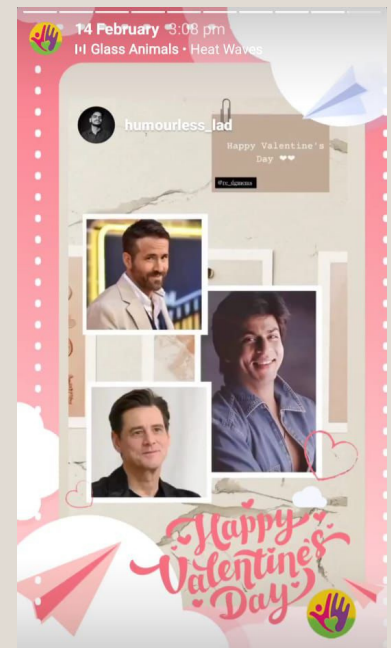
FROM OUR HEART TO YOURS

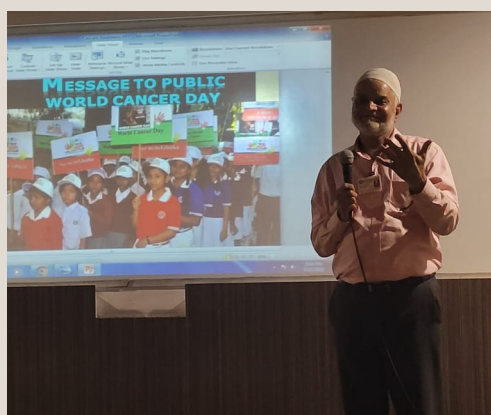

WILL OF FIRE

The Rotaract Club of Deviprasad Goenka Management College of Media Studies organized its annual event, Will of Fire, on 15th March, 2023, at the Madhoprasad Saraf Seminar Hall, RSET Campus. This year's event focused on creating awareness about cancer and its symptoms to spread the message of cancer prevention. The event commenced with a welcome speech by the host Rtr. Sadiya Iqbal, who introduced the guest speaker, Mr. Deshmukh Sagir, the Founder and Chairman of Cancare Research Foundation. Mr. Sagir, a retired Medical Social Worker from Tata Memorial Hospital, Parel, shared his experiences of working with cancer patients and the creation of the Cancare Research Foundation.



The NGO has been actively helping cancer patients with counselling, guidance, home visits, and arranging cancer awareness programs across 17 states in India. Mr. Sagir's speech covered various aspects of cancer awareness, including symptoms, prevention, and its impact on mental health.

He highlighted his achievements of helping 700 children recover from cancer, who are alive and married today. The guest speaker also introduced his 85-year-old grandmother, who accompanied him to the event. The event was a great success, and the impact it had on the students was evident. The pupils developed awareness and understanding of cancer in its actual form.



The Will Of Fire event helped the students understand the importance of cancer prevention and how one can contribute to making a change. The event was a great initiative by the Rotaract Club of DGMC, and it successfully achieved its aim of spreading awareness about cancer.
