# **INTRA-COLLEGIATE BGMJ TOURNAMENT**

## **Official Rulebook**

## 1. Overview

This rulebook outlines the structure, eligibility, gameplay rules, and conduct guidelines for the intra-collegiate BGMI tournament. All participants must comply with every rule to ensure fairness and competitive integrity.

## 2. Eligibility Criteria

1. Participants must be current students of the institution.
2. Participants can participate from only one team in each mode.
3. Teams can participate in both modes: Duo or Squad.
4. The **Team Leader** must complete the registration form and is responsible for communication with the organizers.

## 3. Team Composition

### Duo Mode

- 1 Team Leader + 1 Teammate
- Both must submit UIDs + profile screenshots.

### Squad Mode

- 1 Team Leader + 3 Teammates
- All participants UIDs + profile screenshots must be submitted.

## 4. Registration Requirements

Each team must submit:

1. Full names of all players.
2. BGMI In-Game Name (IGN) and UID of each player.
3. Clear **profile screenshots** showing IGN + UID.
4. Contact details of the Team Leader.
5. Full Roll numbers and Class details of the teammates.

Incomplete registrations will be rejected.

## 5. Technical Requirements

1. Only **mobile devices** are allowed. I-Pads and Tabs are not allowed.
2. Use of **emulators, triggers, external controllers, or modded APKs** is strictly prohibited.
3. Wi-Fi network will be provided for gaming but students are also required to have Mobile networks on backup.
4. Players must check device charging, network strength, and game updates beforehand.
5. No rematches will be given for:
  - Lag or Disconnects
  - Crashes
  - Device issues
  - Network problems

## 6. Match Format

1. Matches will be conducted in **custom rooms** created by organizers.
2. Room ID and password will be shared on the day of the event only.
3. Teams must join the room **within the given time window**.
4. Late entries will not be accommodated.
5. Players must be present on Campus to participate.

## 7. Gameplay Rules

1. Players must use the **registered account/UID** only.
2. Playing from any other account results in immediate disqualification.
3. Teaming with opponents (cross-teaming) is strictly prohibited.
4. Abusive voice chat or text chat is not allowed.

## 8. Behaviour & Fair Play

- Toxic behaviour, harassment, or abuse leads to immediate removal.
- Impersonation, duplicate accounts, or substitution without approval is prohibited.
- Any hacking, cheating, or unfair play results in disqualification of the entire team.

## 9. Disqualification Rules

Instant removal will occur if:

- Wrong UID or unregistered account is used
- Player joins with emulator
- Cross-teaming is detected
- Screenshots or verification documents are found fake
- A non-registered player plays in the match

Final decision rests with tournament officials.

## 10. Proof & Verification

Organizers may request any of the following at any time:

- In-game check
- Post-match screenshot

Failing to provide proof may lead to disqualification.

## 11. Dispute Resolution

- Only Team Leaders may file disputes.
- Officials' decisions are final and binding.

## 12. Prizes & Certificates

Prizes will be distributed during the Award Ceremony of the Annual Sports Day.

Prizes are as follows: Medals and certificates to first and second teams. Trophies to MVP in both modes.
